## **Application Graduate Division**

1. Fill out the application form completely.
2. Write personal testimony (approximately 300 words).
3. Submit the application form, personal testimony, a recent photograph with \$25 non-refundable application fee and transcripts to the campus registrar.
4. Have local Pastor or responsible person complete the personal recommendation and mail it directly to the campus registrar.
5. Application must be completed and accepted prior to enrolling in classes.

## **Transfer and Life Experience Credits**

World Harvest Bible College accepts transfer credit earned in a college or university. Courses acceptable for transfer are evaluated for content. Only those credits which carry a grade of at least "C" or its equivalent may be transferred. In order to request consideration of life experience for practicum credit, the applicant must submit a full resume showing dates of ministry and full responsibilities involved. Verification from an overseer or other recognizable authority must accompany each ministry assignment. While classes may be audited without transcripts, certificates and degrees may only be granted to those who have a high school transcript or GED.
